Joint Secretary


University Grants Commission (UGC), New Delhi

Dr. G. S. Chauhan (Dr. Gambhir Singh Chauhan) is Joint Secretary, University Grants Commission (UGC), New Delhi, and a distinguished academician and higher education administrator with extensive experience in teaching, research, and policy implementation. He began his academic career as a Lecturer at Government Colleges in Haryana and later served as Associate Professor in the Department of Geography at Dr. B. R. Ambedkar College, University of Delhi, contributing significantly to teaching and academic development.

He joined the University Grants Commission in September 2006 as Education Officer and has since held several key administrative positions, including at the UGC South-Eastern Regional Office, Hyderabad, and the Central Regional Office, Bhopal, where he served as Education Officer and Deputy Secretary. Since January 2019, he has been serving as Joint Secretary at UGC, New Delhi, playing an important role in strengthening regulatory frameworks, academic quality, and institutional governance in higher education.

Dr. Chauhan holds a Ph.D. in Geography from the Delhi School of Economics, University of Delhi, along with M.Sc. and M.Phil. degrees from Kurukshetra University. A prolific scholar, he has published over 85 research papers and eight books, including edited volumes on contemporary geographical issues and three books of poetry addressing social and national themes. He has presented research papers and participated in international conferences across Asia, Europe, Africa, and South America.

He has served on several prestigious national and international bodies, including as Member Secretary of the UGC-ISRO high-level committee for curriculum development in Remote Sensing, GIS, and GPS, and as a Steering Committee Member of the International Geographical Union's Commission on Land Use and Land Cover Change. A Chancellor's Nominee to multiple universities and a two-time elected representative to the Indian Science Congress Association, Dr. Chauhan is also the Founder President of Academics for Social Transformation. His areas of specialization include Disaster and Water Resource Management, Desertification, Tourism Geography, and issues related to Socio-Economically Disadvantaged Groups (SEDGs).



## Prof. (Dr.) Suresh Garimella

Chairperson, CIPU Global Advisory Council  
President, University of Arizona, USA

Suresh Garimella serves as the 23rd president of the University of Arizona and University Distinguished Professor in the Department of Mechanical and Aerospace Engineering, positions he assumed on October 1, 2024. He was unanimously appointed by the Arizona Board of Regents following a robust national search. On selecting Garimella to lead the university, Board Chair Cecilia Mata praised his collaborative leadership, experience, and vision, calling him a "tireless champion for students" who is well suited to lead the university into a bright future.

Previously, he was president of the University of Vermont (UVM) from 2019 to 2024. Under his leadership, the university underscored its reputation as a premier flagship research university dedicated to providing a world-class student experience and committed to fulfilling its land-grant mission, a focus he brings to the U of A as well.

Throughout his career, Garimella has emphasized the importance of access and affordability for students, and he has worked to promote excellence in the student learning experience. A professor of mechanical engineering, he is both a highly cited scholar and researcher and a passionate educator, mentoring over 90 graduate students and 50 post-doctoral scholars, 31 of whom were placed in prestigious faculty positions across the world. During his tenure as UVM's president, he led an annual undergraduate seminar class devoted to engaging students in civil discourse on multifaceted contemporary issues.

As a researcher, Garimella has made seminal contributions to the field of electronics thermal management and energy efficiency at micro and nano scales, and in sustainable energy systems technology and policy. He is co-author of more than 625 refereed publications and 16 issued patents, and he has been recognized as an elected Member of the National Academy of Engineering and elected Fellow of the National Academy of Inventors, the American Association for the Advancement of Science and the American Society of Mechanical Engineers.

Garimella also has made important contributions to national and international policy. He served as a member of the National Science Board, which oversees the National Science Foundation and acts as an independent body of advisers to both the President and Congress on policy matters related to science and engineering. He also chairs the research advisory board of Sandia National Laboratories, is a member of the board of directors at Modine and the executive committee for the Council on Competitiveness, and previously served as a Jefferson Science Fellow at the U.S. Department of State and as Senior Fellow for Energy and Climate Partnership of the Americas.

His educational background includes a Ph.D. from the University of California, Berkeley, an M.S. from The Ohio State University, and a bachelor's degree from the Indian Institute of Technology, Madras.

He also served on the UNESCO Policy on Higher Education Drafting Committee representing India. Currently, he serves as Advisor & Professor of Eminence at Jio Institute, Mumbai.



## Dr. Vibha Dhawan

Dr Vibha Dhawan is a distinguished scientist, academic leader, and policy expert with over three decades of association with The Energy and Resources Institute (TERI), dating back to 1985. She served as Vice-Chancellor of the TERI School of Advanced Studies from 2005 to 2007 and is a Fellow of the National Academy of Sciences, India. She also serves as an Adjunct Professor with the Consul General South Asia Partnership at Michigan State University.

Dr Dhawan has authored six books and over 50 research publications and is widely recognised for her contributions to research, innovation, and policy at national and international levels. She is a member of key national committees under the Department of Biotechnology and allied bodies and advises the UN-supported Sustainable Development Solutions Network. She previously co-chaired the T20 Task Force on Clean Energy and Green Transitions.

Under her leadership, several landmark initiatives were established, including the National Centre of Excellence in Green Port & Shipping at TERI and the Micropropagation Technology Park. Her research interests focus on biofuels and bio commodities. He has secured several patents and research grants, guided Ph.D. students, and his scientific publications have received over 13,600 citations. His work to combat predatory publishing as the Chairman, UGC CARE has been appreciated, including a World View article published in NATURE. He has been honored with accolades such as the Sir Ram Nath Chopra Oration, Sardar Vallabh Bhai Patel Award, Waldemar Haffkine Oration, and the V K Joag Best Teacher Award, among others. He has authored books published by esteemed publishers and serves as the Editor-in-Chief of the Journal of Ayurveda and Integrative Medicine.

He actively participates in national committees and policymaking bodies including Ministries of Education, Ayush, and Health, research agencies such as DST, CSIR, DBT, DHR, ICMR, CCRAS, and NITI Aayog among several others. His extensive expertise, innovative research, and leadership roles continue to shape evidence-based Ayurveda and contribute significantly to global public health systems
