Shri. Anurag Singh Thakur is the Former Minister for Information & Broadcasting and Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India. Presently he is a five-time elected Member of the Indian Parliament (Lok Sabha) from Hamirpur, Himachal Pradesh. Previously, he served as a Minister of State for Finance and Corporate Affairs in 2019.

In his capacity as a minister, he has spearheaded numerous pioneering initiatives aimed at advancing both the news and entertainment sectors, while also notably enhancing the nation's medal count.

In 2016, he was commissioned as a regular officer in the Territorial Army at the rank of Lieutenant of the 124 Sikh Regiment, thereby becoming the first sitting BJP Member of Parliament to join as a regular officer. In 2021, he was promoted to the rank of Captain.

Within Parliament, he currently serves as Chairman of Parliamentary Standing Committee on Coal, Mines and Steel, Member - Public Accounts Committee and Member - Joint Committee on the Constitution (One Hundred & Twenty-Ninth Amendment) Bill, 2024 & The Union Territories Laws (Amendment) Bill, 2024. He has been unanimously elected as a member of the Bureau of the Standing Committee on Democracy and Human Rights of the InterParliamentary Union.

In the past, he has been the Chairman of Parliamentary Standing Committee on IT. He was a part of the Indian Parliamentary Delegation, at the 149th InterParliamentary Union (IPU) Assembly in Geneva, where he represented India on UN Affairs. He also represented India at the Parliamentary Committee on WTO and the Steering Committee. During the 16th Lok Sabha, he was appointed as the Chief Whip, Lok Sabha, becoming the youngest to assume the post.

He is the former National President of Bharatiya Janata Yuva Morcha (BJYM- Youth Wing of the Bharatiya Janata Party) and has been the only National President to be appointed for three consecutive terms in the BJP.

Sh. Thakur is an avid sports lover and has contributed immensely to sports in the capacity of a sports administrator. He continues to serve as the President for Himachal Pradesh State Olympic Association and has previously served as the President of the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) and President of Himachal Pradesh Cricket Association (HPCA).

Earlier, he was awarded the Sansad Ratna Award; conferred with Champions of Change 2019 Award; recognized as a "Young Global Leader" by the World Economic Forum and Global Fund made Shri Thakur their "Global Champion" in the category of Public Health.

Prof. (Dr.) V. N. Rajasekharan Pillai is a distinguished academic leader, eminent scientist, and higher education administrator with over five decades of experience in teaching, research, and academic governance in India and abroad. He served as the Vice-Chancellor of Somaiya Vidyavihar University, Mumbai, and earlier as Provost of Somaiya Vidyavihar and Somaiya Ayurvihar. An Elected Fellow of the Indian Academy of Sciences, Prof. Pillai is among India's top-cited chemistry researchers and the founder of an internationally acclaimed research group in Polymer Science. He has supervised 67 doctoral and post doctoral researchers at leading institutions in India, Germany, and Switzerland, including the University of Tübingen, Hochschule Mainz, and the University of Lausanne. Prof. Pillai has held several eminent leadership roles, including Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the University Grants Commission, Executive Director of NAAC, Vice-Chancellor of IGNOU, Mahatma Gandhi University, and Cochin University of Science and Technology. He also served on the UNESCO Policy on Higher Education Drafting Committee representing India. Currently, he serves as Advisor & Professor of Eminence at Jio Institute, Mumbai.



Prof. (Dr.) D. P. Agarwal

Prof. Agrawal was the Founder-Director of the ABV- Indian Institute of Information Technology and Management, Gwalior, India, Gwalior. He was responsible for the conceptualisation, design, and construction of the Institute campus from ground zero. He was also responsible for development and design of new academic programmes with dynamic curriculum, creation of new models of education delivery and assessment, encompassing peer learning, mentoring, self-learning, learning to learn and continuous evaluation, and linkages collaboration with industries and universities abroad.

Prof. Agrawal started his career as a faculty in the Department of Mechanical Engineering, Indian Institute of Technology, Delhi in 1975. In 1994, from being a Professor and Dean at IIT Delhi, he took over as the Joint Educational Adviser (Technical) in the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India. While at the Ministry, he initiated policies for the growth of quality technical education and was instrumental in conceptualising several new institutions in the emerging paradigm of Information Technology. He has contributed to the development of Centres for Excellence in higher technical and polytechnic education. As the National Project Director of the World Bank, he assisted Technician Education Projects. The implementation strategies adopted by him created, for the first time, very high participation of women (30%) in technician education. The outcomes of these projects were rated highly by the World Bank which disseminated the implementation strategies adopted here as a model for other countries.

Prof. Agrawal was the Managing Director of Educational Consultants India Ltd. (EdCIL), a Government of India PSU, where he brought about major changes in the organisational work culture including decentralised decision-making and transferring functional responsibilities to lower executives. He has been very active in teaching and research throughout his career and has supervised over 100 theses including 20 Ph.D.s and published over 150 research papers covering areas of Turbo-Machinery, Fluid Dynamics, Information Technology, Management and E-Governance. His research papers have received awards in India & abroad.

He has shouldered many important national-level responsibilities with distinction. To mention a few: Chairman of Central Regional Committee of AICTE, Chairman/Member of Board of Governors of many technical institutes, Chairman, National Group on Technology Management, DST, Member, working groups for Planning Commission on technical education etc.

Prof. Bhola Ram Gurjar is currently Director at National Institute of Technical Teachers Training and Research (NITTTR), Chandigarh. He holds a PhD in the area of Environmental Risk Analysis from India's premier technological institution IIT Delhi followed by Postdoctoral research on air pollution and its local-to-regional-to-global impacts at Max Planck Institute in Mainz, Germany. He is on lien from IIT Roorkee where he has been a Professor (HAG) of Environmental Engineering in Civil Engineering Department and a Joint Faculty in Centre of Excellence for Transportation Systems. At IIT Roorkee, he has also served as Interim Director of DRDO Industry Academia - Centre of Excellence, Dean of Resources and Alumni Affairs, Head of Centre for Transportation Systems, and Head of the Max Planck Partner Group for Megacities and Global Change. He is on the Board of Directors of IIT Roorkee Development Foundation. Prof. Gurjar has more than 33 years' progressive professional experience in industry, teaching, training, research, and consultancy. He is among the leading academicians and researchers who have worked extensively in the domain of urban (megacity) emissions, air quality, health risk assessment, climate change and environmental sustainability related issues of scientific as well as policy nature. He has (co)authored more than 200 publications including 12 books and one patent. He has developed two popular NPTEL online courses i.e. MOOCs, namely "Sustainable Transportation Systems" and "Air Pollution and Control". As a member, Prof. Gurjar is serving in several national level committees and boards. In recognition of his outstanding contributions in the environment related fields, he has received national/international awards and honors including National Design Award in Environmental Engineering from National Design and Research Forum (NDRF), The Institution of Engineers (India), and START Young Scientist Award from the Scientific Steering Committee of the global change SysTem for Analysis, Research and Training (START), Washington, D.C., U.S.A.
